



Fees and Funding Options

- **There are two main options available, as explained below.**

Option A

Privately Funded

- Minimum attendance for children up to 3 years of age = 4 half-day sessions per week (or two full days per week)
- Minimum attendance for children from 3 years of age = 5 half-day sessions per week (or 2.5 full days per week)

Half-day session (8.30-12.30) = £46

Full-day Session (8.30-16.30) = £81

You may also choose among the following:

- Extended Afternoon (to 17.30) = £10
- Breakfast Club (from 8.15 am) = £4
- Hot Lunch (tailored menu) = £4

We offer a 5% discount for full-time attendance (5 full days a week) and a 10% discount for siblings. Fees are calculated for the whole school term based on the number of weeks in a term, the attendance pattern, and additional options.

In this case, there is no difference in fees based on age group.

Option B

Access to Funding

- Minimum attendance = 7 half-day sessions per week (or 3.5 full days per week)

The funding provided by the Department of Education does not cover our total service costs, and in some cases, it covers less than half of our regular fees. To ensure our provision's high quality, there are optional charges for additional hours and specialist workshops (specialist classes), materials, and consumables. Termly fees depend on several factors, e.g.:

1. Age of your child (<2 years, =2 years, and 3+ years).
2. Pattern of weekly attendance and extra selections.
3. Number of weeks with entitlement funding and additional weeks (without funding).
4. Crucially, the amount of funding you are entitled to and have confirmed is in place for any given term (either 15 hours or 30 hours per week).

For instance, assume a typical term of 12 weeks and that you receive 30 hours of entitlement funding for the whole term (i.e., there are 12 “funded weeks”). Also, assume that no extra options have been selected, that is, no hot lunches or attendance for extended afternoons.

Case 1: Cost per week with 30 hours of entitlement funding (for a typical term)

	3.5 days	4 days	4.5 days	5 days

Case 2: Cost per week with 15 hours of entitlement funding (for a typical term)

3.5 days	4 days	4.5 days	5 days
£199	£241	£273	£325

Breakfast club (from 8.15 am), extended afternoon, and hot lunches are additional options, which cost the same as in Option A.
